PRODUCT USE

ESHAvent® was developed for application under hot asphalt or torch-applied systems. Its self-adhesive properties and the perforations in the aluminum foil sheet on its underside "spot welds" ESHAvent® to the substrate until a waterproofing layer can be applied on top. ESHAvent®'s non-permeable layer of aluminum foil creates an effective vapor escape system which prevents roof blistering and also acts as a heat shield, protecting underlying roof insulation from the heat of a torch or hot asphalt. The aluminum layer eliminates the need for a cover board over isocyanurate, extruded and expanded roof insulations. Please consult Malarkey's Technical Services Department for approval of roof systems.

COMPOSITION & MATERIALS

ESHAvent® is a thermally-adhered, bituminous, waterproofing and ventilating membrane. The top surface is coated with a weathering grade of SBS bitumen (asphalt) and surfaced with fine mineral sand. The underside is covered with a perforated aluminum foil sheet and protected by a release sheet that is removed prior to installation. The topside edge of the sheet has a 3" (76 mm) selvage for lap joint seams.

APPLICATION

ESHAvent® shall be applied as specified. Roof decks should be sound, dry, smooth, meet necessary local requirements, and provide positive drainage. Do not apply wet membrane sheets. If applied in cold weather, follow cold weather application instructions and general requirements. Precautions must be taken over EPS roof insulation. See Malarkey's Specification Manual for specific installation instructions, or contact our Technical Services Department for details.

STORAGE & HANDLING

ESHAvent® requires dry storage and protection from weather. Store on end and off the ground on pallets.

WARRANTY
