PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

An advantage of Malarkey 950 SEBS asphalt is its tremendous adhesive capabilities to BUR membranes, roof insulations and most roofing substrates.

Composition and Materials: Malarkey SEBS Roofing Asphalt is manufactured from a tested bitumen mixture with heat-resistant SEBS (Styrene-Ethylene-Butylene-Styrene) and packaged into 50 lb. kegs. The polymer modified asphalt is manufactured to meet the following performance criteria:

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

950 SEBS Roofing Asphalt may be heated to high temperatures with no appreciable degradation, due to the use of heat resistant (SEBS) polymer. However, the recommended application temperature, the Equiviscous Temperature (EVT), results in the best adhesion of the membranes. Application at temperatures that are more than 25F (4C) above or below the EVT may result in inadequate adhesion or improper coverage rate. Malarkey recommends the use of modified base sheets, such as 501, rather than standard BUR base sheets. Refer to Malarkey Specification Manual for general application procedures.

WARRANTY

Malarkey offers various warranties with the use of Malarkey SEBS Roofing Asphalt to meet specific requirements. The warranty package includes 5, 10, 15, 20, 25 and 30-year limited and unlimited coverage.
